Abita Amber : Marzen : Louisiana : 5.5%

Brilliant amber body with rich roasted grain flavors and a toasty, dry finish

Abita Purple Haze: Marzen : Louisiana : 4.2%

A subtle purple coloration and haze, a fruity aroma and a tartly sweet taste

Bell's Hopslam: Double IPA: Michigan: 10%

Brewed with honey and hoppy as hell. 136 IBU (international bitterness units)

Bell's Oberon: Hefeweizen: Michigan: 5.8%

A light bodied, clean finishing hefeweizen with flavors of citrus and fresh baked bread

Bell's Porter: Porter: Michigan: 5.6%

Fairly light bodied for a porter. Roasted coffee flavors with a bittersweet chocolate finish

Chimay Cinq Cents : Trappist Tripel : Belgium : 8%

Cloudy golden body with floral aromas and hints of coriander in the finish

Delirium Tremens : Strong Pale Ale : Belgium : 9%

Golden body with flavors of banana and wheat with a fruity bubblegum sweetness

Dogfish Head 60 Minute IPA: 6%

Strong hop bitterness leading to a nice malty citrus flavor.

Dunedin Brewmaster Reserve Nitro Stout: Dunedin, Florida: 4.8%

Erie Railbender Ale: Scottish Ale: Pennsylvania: 6.8%

Amber body with low carbonation. Nutty & toasty with a clean, malty finish

Fullers ESB: England: 5.9%

Medium body with a light sugar sweetness

Guinness: Ireland: 4.2%


Smooth with a bittersweet reward

Hazed & Infused: American Pale Ale: 4.8%

Grapefruit, not as hoppy as it smells, has a great malt backbone

Highland Gaelic Ale : Amber Ale : North Carolina : 5.8%

Red brown body with flavors of toasty malt and an earthy hops bitterness in the finish





Hook and Ladder Backdraft Brown : Brown Ale : Maryland : 5.5%

Smooth brown ale with dry roasted pecan flavors and a slight chocolate bitterness

Krusovice Cerne: Czech Republic: 3.8%

Full sweet caramel taste and a light hop flavor

Left Hand Milk Stout : Milk Stout : Colorado : 5.2%

Adult chocolate milk. Medium bodied with bittersweet chocolate, espresso, and dark malt flavors.

Leinenkugel Sunset Wheat: 4.9%

Has a light wheat touch, but crisp with a decent body

Lindemans Framboise : Raspberry Lambic : Belgium : 4%

Brilliant red body with low carbonation and a candy sweet, slightly tart raspberry flavor

Lindemans Peche/ Pomme : Peach/ Apple Lambic : Belgium : 4%

Sparkling body with flavors of champagne and vanilla with mild fruit flavor in the finish

Maduro Oatmeal Brown Ale: 5.5%

A hearty brown ale that benefits from the silky mouthfeel provided by oatmeal

Magners Irish Cider: Draught Cider: Ireland: 4.5%

Made from the 17 different varieties of apples grown in Magners orchards

North Coast Scrimshaw: Pilsner: California: 4.4%

Light & pale bodied with the clean, dry finish of German lager hops

Paulaner Salvator: Germany :7.9%

A bit malty with some caramel and light buttery characteristics

Rogue Dead Guy Ale: Maibock: Oregon: 6.6%

Medium bodied with average carbonation. Toasted nut & caramel flavors with a spicy presence of hops

Rogue Juniper Pale Ale: 5.3%

Nice hint of sweet juniper, fresh grapefruit and a small amount of malt.

Sam Adams Cherry Wheat: 5.2%

Tangy, refreshing that is light on the palate and long on complexity.

Sea Dog Blue Paw : Fruit Beer : Maine : 4.6%

Light bodied and clean with pale wheat flavors, average carbonation, and a dry blueberry finish

Sierra Nevada ESB: 5.9%

Citrusy notes with a hoppy bite

Smithwicks: 4.5%

Smells like baked bread, somewhat malty & sweet



Stone Arrogant Bastard Ale: Strone Ale: California: 7.2%

For the arrogant bastard in all of us. An intense malt bomb up front, hop bomb in the finish

Stone Old Guardian: Barleywine: California: 11.3%

A sweeter barleywine with flavors of brown sugar and caramel, intense bitterness from aggressive hopping

Spaten Optimator : Doppelbock : Germany : 7.2%

A strong, dark lager with deep toffee and roasted grain flavors. Finishes with a slight alcohol warmth

Woodchuck Pear Cider : Draught Cider : Vermont : 4%

Crystal clear body with low carbonation and the mild sweetness of ripe pears

Wittekerke: Witbier: Belgium: 5%

A true Belgian white ale. Cloudy with a light orange flavor

Tetley's English Ale: Pale Ale: England: 5%

Creamy nitrogen conditioned body with vanilla flavors and a slight bitter finish

Unibroue Maudite: Belgian Strong Dark Ale: 8%

Bready, brown sugar sweetness

Youngs Double Chocolate: Sweet Stout: 5.2%

Paulaner Hefe-Weissbier : Hefeweizen : Germany : 5.5%

Hazy orange body with low carbonation. Flavors of citrus and biscuits with a clean orange finish

Kronenbourg 1664: Pale Lager: France: 5.9%

Light bodied, earthy, and crisp with mild flavors of cereal grains and toasted bread

Dunedin Apricot: 4.9%

Light ale, brewed with natural apricot puree

Tangy, vibrant & pungent along with an insane amount of malty barley
